

One-day training program on Biological Control of Pests in Sugarcane under SCSP

Under the framework of the Scheduled Cast Sub Plan (SCSP), a one-day training program on 'Biological Control of Pests in Sugarcane' was organised by the ICAR-Indian Sugarcane Research Institute (ISRI), Biological Control Centre, Pravaranagar (MS) at the Krantiagarani Dr. G.
